



The project at Old Bread Street was started in 2005 with the concept to develop a long derelict Grade II Listed Victorian soap works & adjacent land into flats for a local housing association.

My involvement was from the construction phase onwards.

The scheme required the addition of internal floors, & extensive restoration & repair to external masonry. Although it was designed for a steel or concrete frame, the contractor had a preference for timber frame construction, which was eventually used throughout. This method of construction was new to the practice.

There are 54 flats both refurbished & new build. The project was completed summer 2009.
